Dear Parents/ Carers,

Thank you for allowing us the time to consider what our home learning offer will be, as of next week.

As previously mentioned, all children will receive remote learning on Tuesday 5th January. This will be uploaded onto Class Dojo. From Wednesday 6th January, critical worker children will be in school and remote learning will continue for all other children. The children will have access to online lessons for English and Maths with us using White Rose Maths videos and Oak National Academy English videos. The videos will enable the children to receive 'taught' lessons as they would in school, with each video teaching the concept of the lesson and taking time to pause and complete activities. Worksheets to be completed will be uploaded via Class Dojo. There is an expectation that all children complete the English and Maths tasks every day and either send a screen shot or scan of the completed work to their class teacher via Class Dojo by the end of each day. This will allow teachers to check the children's work and respond.

We will also be setting tasks for subjects such as Science, Topic and RE. Again, please upload photographs of work to be celebrated.

Teachers will be available to support all learning each day via Class Dojo and answer any questions you may have, so please do stay in touch.

Next week, you will receive an outline of the work to be completed each day as well as an example timetable. It is extremely important that the children maintain a school routine and we encourage you to follow the recommended timetable. The children have worked incredibly hard this past term to catch up on lost learning and in order for them to not fall further behind, it is important that you support them by ensuring they complete the work set. We will be contacting parents who do not submit completed work.

If you do not have relevant access to receive remote learning at home, please do contact the school by email so that we can provide you with a paper version of work to be completed. This will be available to collect from the school next week. We would ask that you collate all work completed to be handed back into school by Friday 15th January or send photographs of the work via Class Dojo if you are able.
